

# Milk Paint Guide

1. Clean your furniture thoroughly by using a white rag + a 50/50 mix of water and denatured alcohol (available at your local hardware store). Let your furniture dry.
2. Using 120 grit sandpaper, sand down any scratches or dings until smooth. Dust with a clean shop cloth.
3. Stir your paint, and apply your first coat with a house paint brush. Don't worry if the first coat appears thin. Let the first coat dry for 2 hours.
4. Using 220 grit sandpaper, lightly smooth down any drips or unnoticed scratches or dings. Dust off any debris with a clean shop cloth.
5. Stir your paint, and apply your second coat. Let the second coat dry for 2 hours. If needed, apply a third coat.
6. Let the paint cure for 2-3 weeks before setting heavy objects on your furniture.
7. Secure the lid on any unused paint and store inside at room temperature.
